

NAVY GETAWAYS (RECREATIONAL LODGING) PATRON ELIGIBILITY

All reservations are made on a first come, first serve basis without regard to rate or rank. Reservations may be made up to 1 year in advance for Active Duty Members and 6 months in advance for all other eligible patrons. *The sites reserve the right to cancel any reservation that does not meet Navy Getaways stay policy*.

Eligibility

- > Armed Forces active duty members and their family members
- > Armed Forces retirees retired from active duty and their family members
- > Reserve Component members and their family members
- > Retired Armed Forces and Reserve Component members and their family members
- ▶ U.S. DoD civilians (both APF and NAF)
- Honorably discharged veterans with 100% Service-connected disability
- Veterans awarded the Purple Heart
- Veterans who are former prisoners of war
- > All veterans with a service-connected disability
- Individuals assessed, approved, and designated as the primary family caregiver of eligible veterans under the Department of Veteran Affairs Pro-gram of Comprehensive Assistance for Family Caregivers
- > Guests of the Armed Forces as determined by the Commanding Officer
- Medal of Honor Recipients
- Un-remarried surviving spouses of personnel who died while on active duty or while in retired status, and un-remarried former spouses who were married to military members for at least 20 years while the military member was on active duty to the Armed Forces
- Foreign nationals and sponsored guest may have additional restrictions, please verify site page or contact the site for more information.
- * *Guests must provide required identification (Military ID or CAC), or be sponsored by ID holder.

**Guests are responsible for verifying all policies prior to arrival. Policies may vary based on the installation and/or location. This may affect (but not limited to) certain guest eligibility such as DoD civilians, contractors, retired civilians, sponsors, foreign nationals, etc. Other restrictions may apply but not listed.
